### JOHN B. HARSH DIES; RITES AT CASSODAY

John B. Harsh, 77, of 610 South Main, died Sunday at his home.

Mr. Harsh came to El Dorado in 1923 and lived here for 20 years before moving to Wichita. He returned here in 1955.

He was formerly employed by the Boeing company and was a retired farmer and stockman.

He was a member of Patmos Lodge No. 97 A.F.&A.M.

Mr. Harsh was born Dec. 30, 1887, at Kansas City. He and Pearl Brandley were married June 8, 1910, at Matfield Green.

Survivors include the wife of the home; one daughter, Mrs. Betty Jo Wilcox, 513 North Arthur; three sisters, Mrs. Gladys Burke, 423 South Washington, Mrs. Marita McIntosh, Olathe, Kan., Mrs. Llouvinia Baker, Bartlesville, Okla.; four brothers, Sam and Ray Harsh of Cassoday, Dewey and Milton, both of Wichita.

Funeral services will be held Tuesday at 2 p.m. at the Cassoday Methodist Church. Interment will be made in Cassoday cemetery.

The casket will not be opened at the service. Friends may call at the Kirby Funeral Home or at the church prior to service time.
